Properties: Digestive, antibacterial.
Notes: Whole pods or powder.



7. Ginger

Origin: Uganda, Kenya, Nigeria
Properties: Anti-inflammatory,

Notes: Fresh, dried, or ground.



8. African Basil

Origin: Kenya, Ghana, Togo
Properties: Antioxidant, supports
respiratory health.
Notes: For herbal teas and ethnic
cuisine.



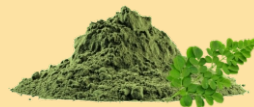
9. Okra (Gumbo)

Origin: Burkina Faso, Ivory Coast,
Kenya
Properties: Fiber, folates – digestive
health.
Notes: Fresh or dried.



10. Moringa

Origin: Kenya, Ghana
Properties: Superfood – protein,
iron, vitamin A.
Notes: Powder, dried leaves, or capsules.



11. Black-Eyed Peas (Kunde)

Origin: Kenya, Uganda
Properties: Rich in fiber and plant protein.
Notes: Dried or pre-cooked.



12. Rosemary

Origin: Eritrea, Egypt, Kenya
Properties: Antioxidant, enhances memory.
Notes: Fresh or dried.



13. Hibiscus Flowers (Karkadè)

Origin: Sudan, Burkina Faso
Properties: Vitamin C, regulates blood pressure.
Notes: For infusions and refreshing drinks



14. Tarragon

Origin: Egypt, Kenya
Properties: Digestive, stimulates appetite.
Notes: Used in teas and cooking.



15. Cacao

Origin: Ivory Coast, Ghana
Properties: Flavonoids – mood and heart health.
Notes: Beans, paste, or powder.

Properties: Boosts metabolism, vitamin C.
Notes: Fresh, dried, or powdered.
